

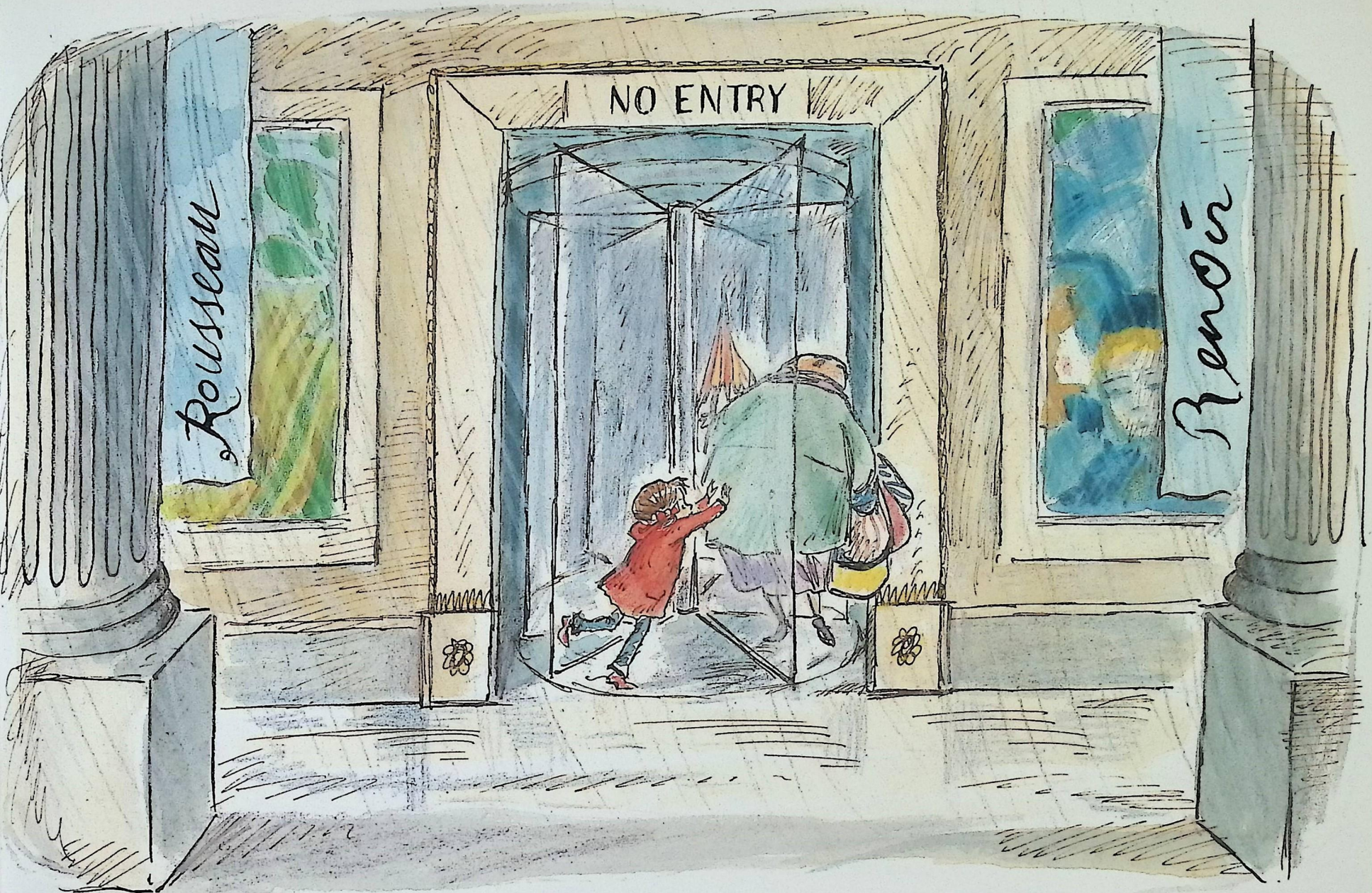

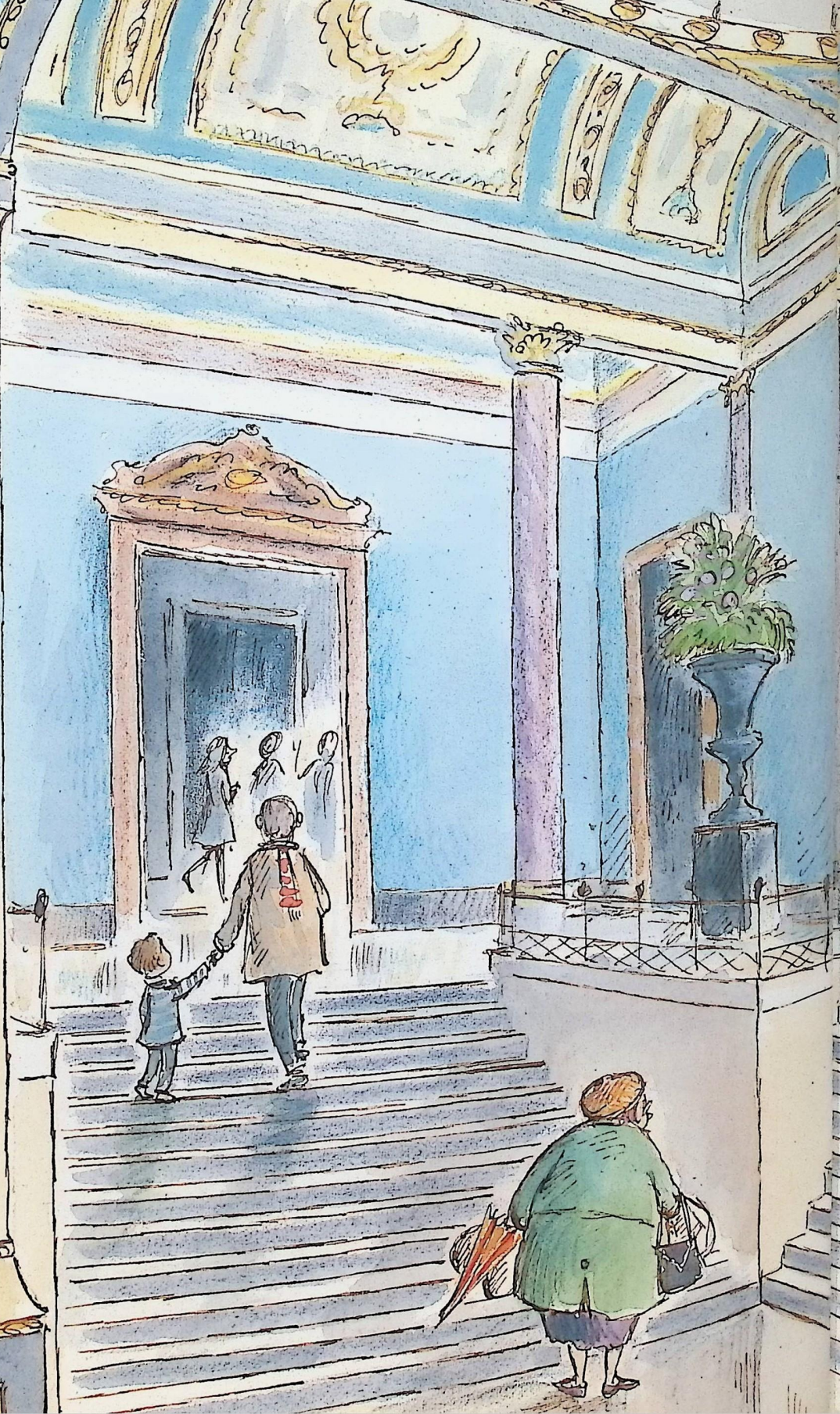

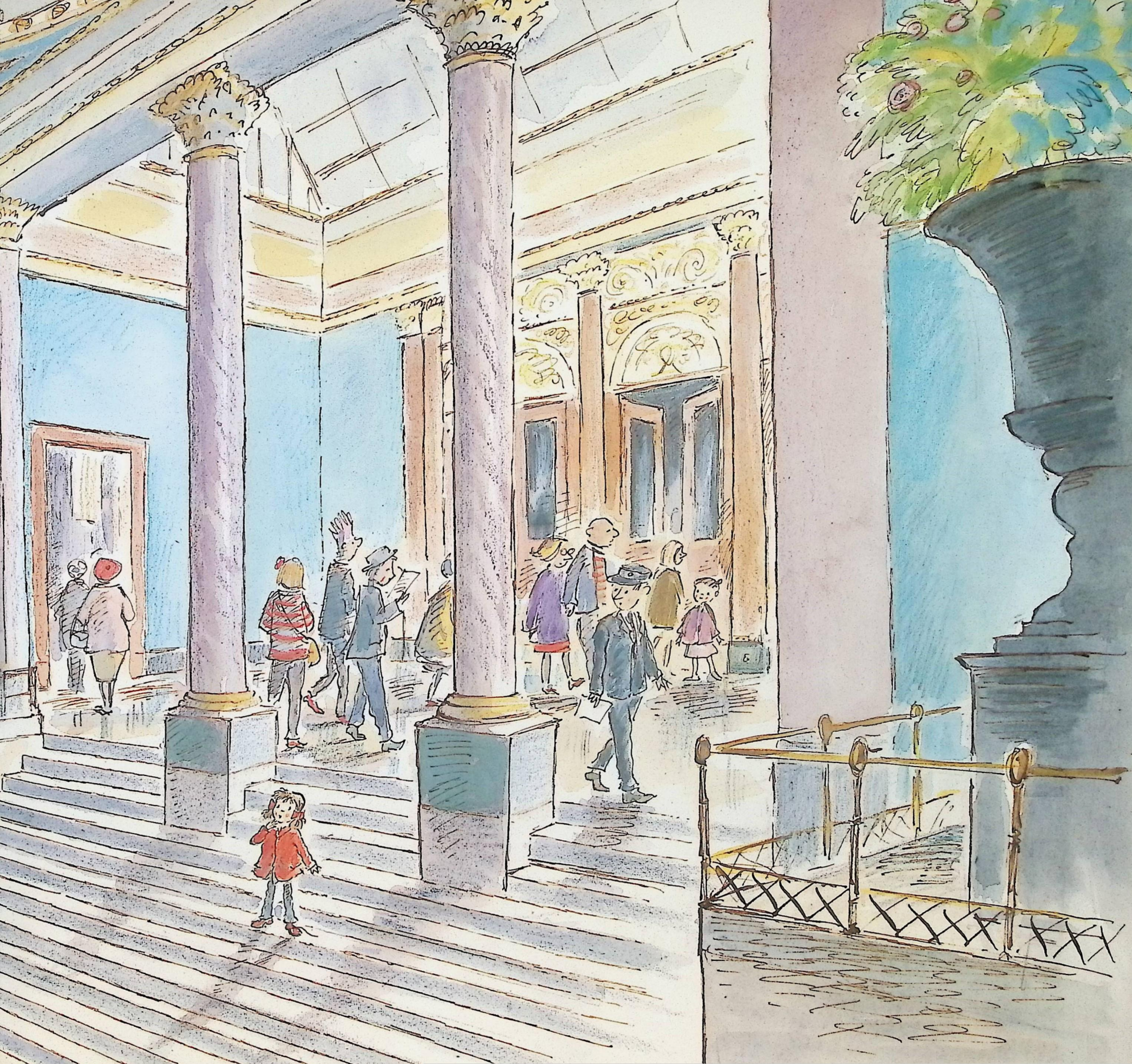
Katie had never been to

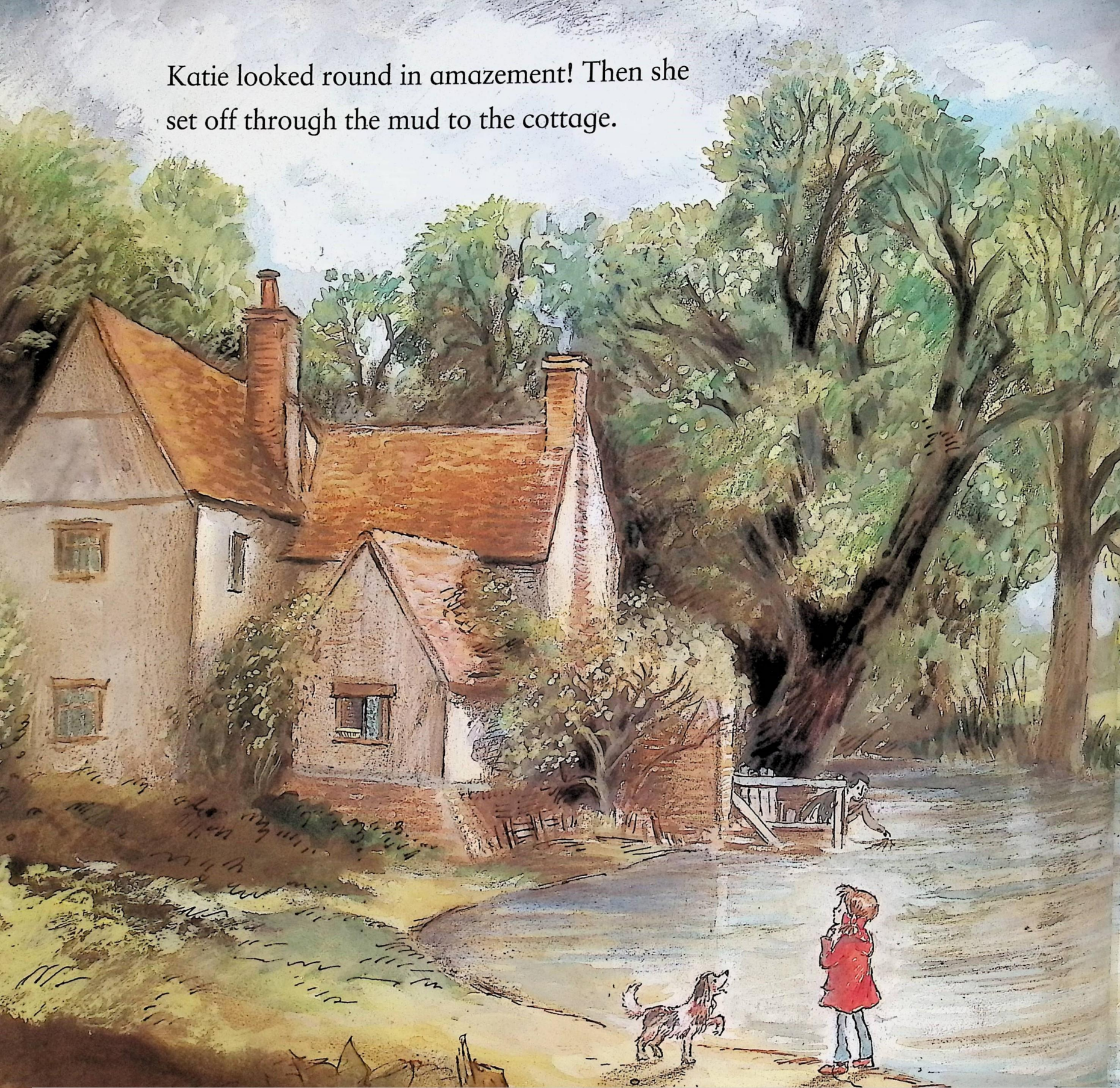
The Hay Wain by John Constable, she read.
