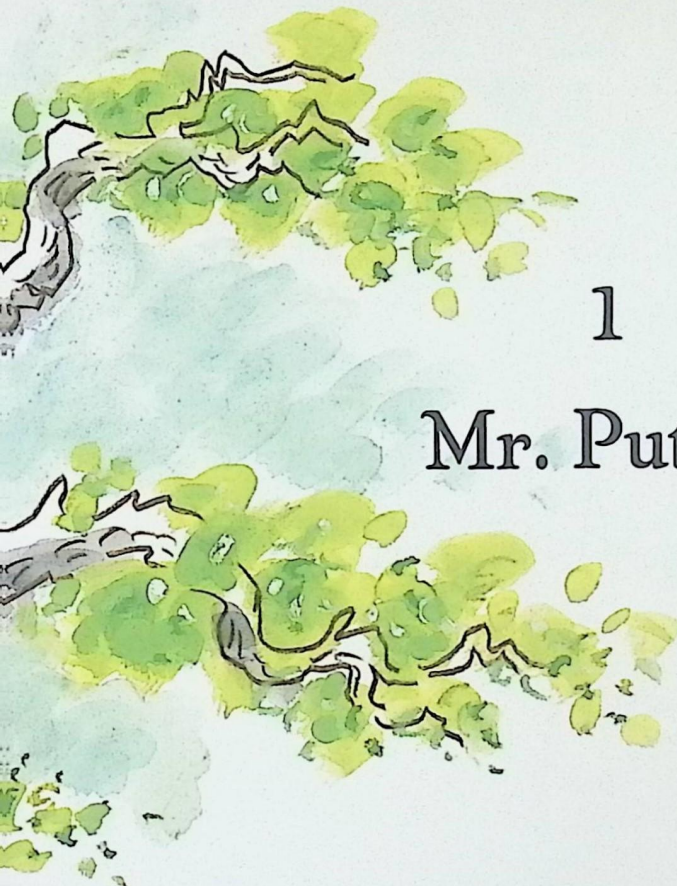

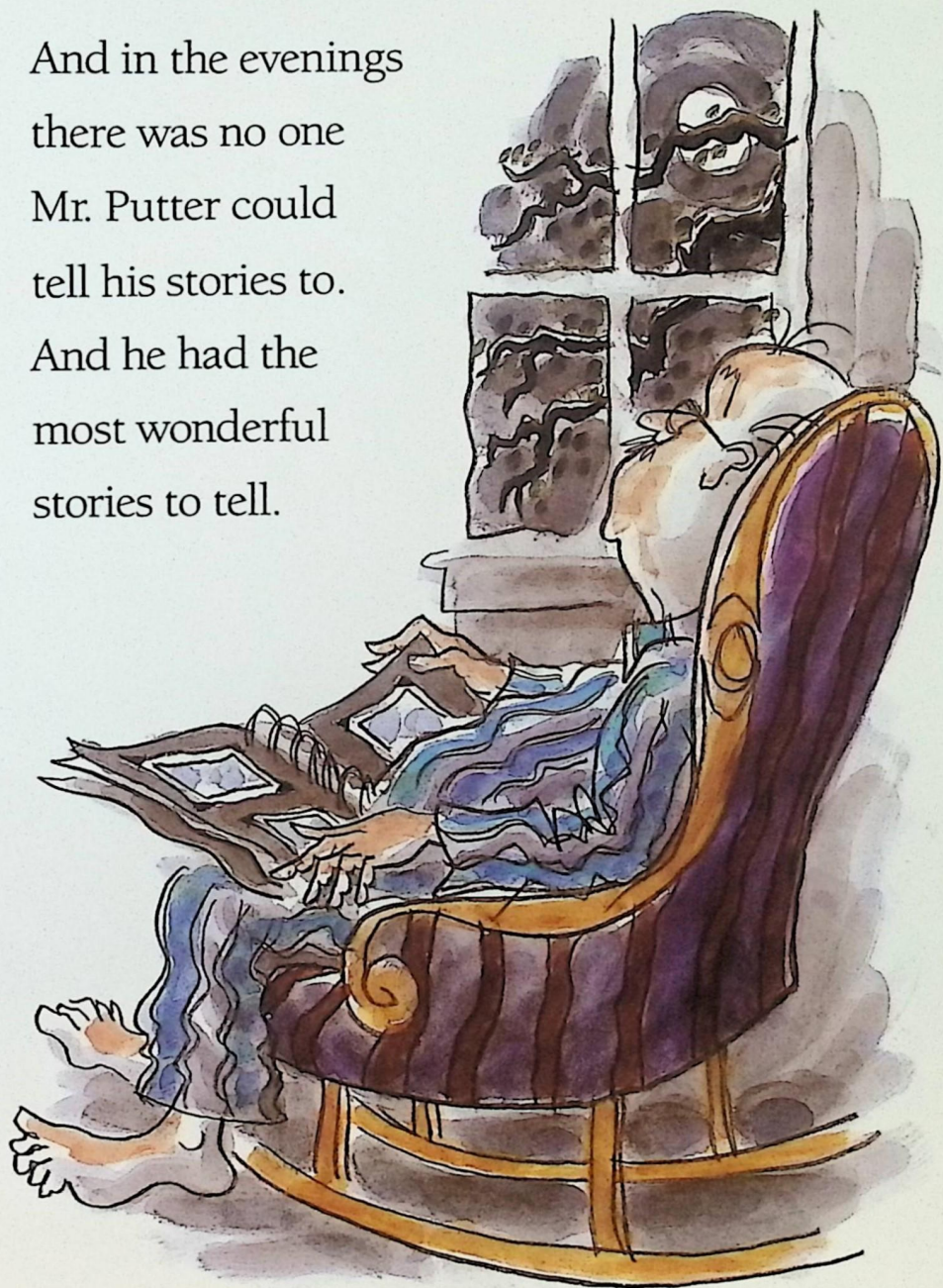
Before he got his fine cat, Tabby,

to share his English muffins.

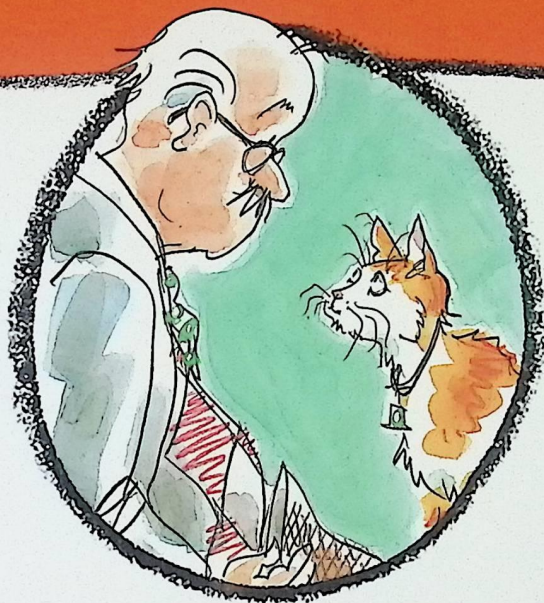
In the afternoons he had no one

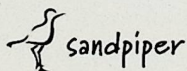
