# KINDERGARTEN AND FIRST GRADE HISTORY

#### INTRODUCTION

Teaching history in kindergarten and first grade is a very different exercise compared to that of later grammar school years.

The Veritas Press History Curriculum used in 2<sup>nd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grades is specifically geared to having the children master a timeline in history, while learning many important facts along the way.

Before children begin those later history courses, however, it is crucial for them to be able to answer the question, "What is history?" The *Bede's History* books used by these lesson plans in kindergarten and first grade lay the groundwork for their later years of study. Upon completion, children will better understand timelines, geography, their own history, the history of the church, and much more.

The instructor should read the book to the student from the perspective of Bede, the yarn ball. Students should simply follow the instructions you give as you read the book aloud to them. Most projects will require assistance from the instructor. Take your time and make this enjoyable. These plans are designed to fill a school year by being used only once a week. As this is meant to be an exploratory introduction to history, we do not recommend grading the student's work.

Look ahead in the book to gather materials for upcoming projects. Craft or other project pages that need to be cut out are located at the back of the book, and the projects will refer you to those pages as necessary.
