One twenty-nine, the **Pentecost**, Jesus sent the Holy Spirit—what a rush!
Then **The Early Church**, the gospel proclaimed, back in AD 31.
Stephen, the First Martyr, stoned to death in Acts chapter 6 and through 7.
Then **The Conversion of Paul**, who was zealous in persecuting the Christian.
Then 133, **First Gentile Converts**, Peter preaches the gospel to Cornelius,
Followed by the **Letter of James** in AD 44.

One forty-two is **First Letter to the Corinthians**.

Paul's **Second Letter to the Corinthians** about our reconciliation to our God through Christ.
One forty-four, **Letter to the Romans**, introduces the gospel to them.
One forty-five, **Paul's Arrest and Trial**, caused a riot down at the Temple.
Paul in Rome, preached to Jews in Rome; his **Letter to Colossians** defends Christ's deity.

Paul's **Letter to Philemon** in AD 61 tells about his runaway slave.
One forty-nine, **Letter to the Ephesians**, all about church unity.
Paul's **Letter to the Philippians** deals with squabbles and Judaizers.
Then Paul's **First Letter to Timothy** says stand strong in prayer.

One fifty-two, Paul's **Letter to Titus**; he was a minister down in Crete.
Then Paul's **Second Letter to Timothy** in AD 63.
In the same year, a **Letter by Jude**, Jesus' half-brother, warns the church.
Then the **First Letter by the apostle Peter** boldly testifying of Christ.
Now one fifty-six, **Second Letter of Peter**, then the **Letter to the Hebrews**.
Shadows of the Old Testament replaced by reality.

One fifty-eight, the **Letters by John**, Jesus came to the earth so we could get along.
Finally, **The Revelation to John**, visions of the end.
And the **Closing of the Canon**, back in AD 367,
Not just the words of men but the Word of God.
